Johnson and Johnson Vaccine Update

(April 13, 2021) The Center for Disease Control and Federal Drug Administration have placed a pause on the use of the Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccine while they review reports of rare adverse events. Due to this pause, the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District is cancelling the Johnson and Johnson Covid-19 Immunization clinics for April 13th and 14th. People with an appointment will be contacted to reschedule. The April 15th, 16th and 17th clinics will continue as planned with the Moderna vaccine. The Moderna and Pfizer vaccines are not a part of the investigation.

Anyone who received the Johnson and Johnson vaccine and has had a severe headache, abdominal pain, leg pain, or shortness of breath within three weeks after vaccination should contact their health care provider. Health Care Providers should report adverse events to the Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System at <https://vaers.hhs.gov/reportevent.html>.
