**ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF DEEP-LUNG BREATH ANALYSIS MECHANISM**  
***(Condition of Bail)***

On \_\_\_\_\_, this Court ordered as a condition of bail, that \_\_\_\_\_ (“Defendant”) install on his/her primary motor vehicle a deep-lung breath analysis mechanism, (called the “device” herein), to make impractical the operation of the motor vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected, and further prohibited Defendant from operating any motor vehicle in a public place which is not equipped with such a device.

The Court finds that the Defendant has been discharged from bail and is no longer required to comply with the conditions thereof, or that the Court has removed the requirement of the device as a condition of bail in this case, and that the Defendant is entitled to have the device removed from his/her primary motor vehicle.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that, unless the Defendant is subject to an order requiring the device, unrelated to the criminal charge to which this Order applies, (specified below), the provider of the device shall remove the same from the Defendant’s primary motor vehicle upon receipt of a file-stamped copy of this signed order.
