**ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF DEEP-LUNG BREATH ANALYSIS MECHANISM**  
***(Condition of Occupational or Essential Need License)***

On \_\_\_\_\_, this Court ordered, as a condition of an occupational or essential need license, that \_\_\_\_\_ (“Applicant”) install a deep-lung breath analysis mechanism, (called the “device” herein), on his/her primary motor vehicle to make impractical the operation of the motor vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected, and further prohibited Applicant from operating any motor vehicle in a public place which is not equipped with such a device.

The Court finds that the Applicant’s occupational or essential need license has expired, or that the requirement in the order granting such license for an ignition interlock device has been satisfied or is no longer applicable, and that the Applicant is entitled to have the device removed from his/her primary motor vehicle.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that, unless the Applicant is subject to an order requiring the device, unrelated to the occupational or essential need license to which this Order applies, the provider of the device shall remove the device from the Applicant’s primary motor vehicle upon receipt of a file-stamped copy of this signed order.
